Knowing Your Uniform

Each student should know his/her uniform part numbers/sizes – garment bag, shako, shako box, jacket number, raincoat number. It is easy to get pieces mixed up when you are in a room full of people wearing the same uniform. You are held accountable for the pieces you've been issued.

Preparing Your Uniform for the Marching Season:

All pants should be hemmed 2-3/4 inches from the floor **with marching shoes on**. You **MAY NOT** cut any of the length from the pants before hemming them. Our uniforms are used for years and must be able accommodate students of all heights.

Under your uniform you will need to wear a t-shirt that doesn't show when your jacket is on (preferably black/dark), boxers/shorts, and black socks that cover the ankle.

Maintaining Your Uniform:

Uniforms should be dry cleaned (both pants and jacket) on a regular basis. The Town & Country Cleaners will dry clean the uniform for \$5 (a bargain!)
